Below are the policies of the entire Music Department regarding participation in **auditioned ensembles**. Our department feels that, in order to provide opportunities to all students, it is important to renew our commitment to holding students accountable to each other. By ensuring that all students are committed to the groups they are in, we also ensure that their peers are able to learn and grow to the greatest extent possible. By ensuring that all students support one another on stage and off, we recognize that part of being a performer is the work we do as a team before and after the performance. We ask that you carefully read below, and return this signed form indicating your understanding and willingness to adhere to these policies.

- ★ Our Spring, 2019 showcase date is Saturday, May 11 at 7pm for auditioned ensembles.
- ★ Students may have no more than 2 **unexcused** absences from rehearsal in a month. More than 2 **unexcused** absences per month could result in immediate dismissal from the ensemble (for information about PVPA's absence policy, please see p.29 of the community handbook).
- ★ Students are expected to be present for rehearsals on **all** days, but especially in the weeks before the show. Please do not schedule appointments or vacations in the 2 weeks preceding a showcase.
- ★ All students are required to be present at showcase performances **40 minutes before** the showcase until **40 minutes after** the showcase ends (we anticipate ending by 9:45pm). After the last performance, **all students** are required to be part of the breakdown/load-out process.
- ★ Any student who must arrive late or leave early from a showcase performance must alert the ensemble director regarding their absence at least 1 week prior to the showcase **in writing.** (see missing rehearsal form on the music department website and attached).
- ★ Students who experience family or health emergencies may submit relevant information and will be required to complete an alternate assignment to demonstrate what they have learned. Any student who misses a showcase performance without meeting the above requirements will not earn credit in the course.

By signing below you indicate that you have made note of our showcase date and understand our expectation that your student be present in rehearsal and at the showcase from 6:20pm until 40 minutes after the final performance ends.
