Choose a *simple* song to reproduce. Your task is to copy the first 30 seconds of sounds and notes from the song as exactly as you can. Your work will be judged based on its accuracy, but also your creativity in finding or reproducing the sounds and effects in your song. Please take all of the following steps as you recreate your song so that you can get credit for each step of the process:

Make an exhaustive list of ALL of the different sounds and instruments that occur in the song then decide as a group whether you will play them live or use MIDI to reproduce them. Please use the following format or something similar:
